1. Authors of accepted presentations will be notified of acceptance via e-mail communication by 30 March 2012.

The deadline for completion of the Participant Response Form will be strictly enforced. This must be accompanied by a registration form and registration fee.
3. Presenters will be notified of their scheduled session day and time after the Participant Response Form has been completed. Presenters are expected to present their submissions on the scheduled day(s) and time(s) indicated. Poster presenters can be scheduled for multiple days and times.
4. If a completed form is not received and the presenter is not registered by 30 June 2012, presentations will be removed from the programme.
5. Removal from the programme will result if any of these guidelines are not met.
